Content Editing

1 Is the conflict or central issue clear in my story?
2 Does my title attract the reader's interest?
3 Does my opening hook the reader and entice him/her to read more?
4 Does the middle contain what's needed to inform, engage, and bring my story to a close?
5 Does my ending answer outstanding questions and provide the reader with a satisfactory close?
6 Will my ending produce the desired feeling in the reader?
7 Did I check all verifiable facts?
Style, Grammar, Punctuation
 Did I use only one space after the ending punctuation mark of each sentence?
2 Did I replace general words with specific ones?
3 Did I use action verbs as much as possible, e.g., run, jump, yell, sing, etc.?
4 Did I appeal to my other senses in addition to sight wherever possible?
5 Did I avoid repeating the same word in the same or nearby sentences?
6 Did I use words for all numbers less than or equal to 100 and numerals for all numbers greater than or equal to 101?
7 Have Lused a paper copy for my final edit?



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8 If using text-to-speech programs to proofread, have I listened to my text and made desired corrections?
9Have I run both grammar and spell checkers on my piece?
10Have I scrolled through my story and looked for all notifications of possible grammar, spelling, and/or punctuation mistakes?
